

Dear Compulabel Customer:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Compulabel brand products are in compliance with the hazardous substances requirements expressed in the EU directive 2002/95/EC and the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) directive 2002/96/EC. The substances under restriction include Cadmium, Mercury, Lead, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PDBE).

Maximum tolerance levels: (measured by weight in homogeneous materials)

Lead	1000ppm
Mercury	1000ppm
Hexavalent chromium	1000ppm
Polybrominated biphenyls	1000ppm
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers	1000ppm
Cadmium	100ppm

In addition, based on letters provided by our suppliers, our products are also compliant with CONEG (Council of the congress of Northeast Governors) Model Toxic Legislation, and the European Union Directive 94/62/EC.
